## *The Gospel of Luke*

### ***What is a lectionary?***

A lectionary is a list of scripture readings assigned to be read on a particular day. This tradition of a lectionary has roots in Jewish worship of long ago and was continued by the early Christians.

Not all Christians use the same lectionary, but many Lutheran, Catholic, Presbyterian, Methodist and other Christian churches around the world use the Revised Common Lectionary, a three-year cycle. Each year the Gospel of Matthew, Mark, or Luke is read primarily with the Gospel of John interspersed throughout all three years. Consequently, if a person worshipped every Sunday for three years, he or she would be able to hear the majority of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.

Each year begins with the season of Advent and is referred to as:

Year A: Primarily the Gospel of Matthew

Year B: Primarily the Gospel of Mark

Year C: Primarily the Gospel of Luke

### ***What do we know about the Gospel writer Luke?***

Luke is also the author of the book of Acts.

Luke is not an eyewitness of the ministry of Jesus, but relies on those who were there (Luke 1:21)

Luke is well-educated.

Luke is acquainted with both the Old Testament and the Hellenistic literary techniques.

It is unclear if Luke is Jewish or Gentile.

### ***What is unique about the Gospel of Luke?***

Luke is full of contrasts. (Example: men/women; old/young; angels/shepherds)

Luke contains much liturgy. (Example: Mary's Magnificat; Simeon's Song)

Prayer is an important part of this Gospel. Watch how often Jesus prays before major decisions.

Luke's Gospel includes outsiders (Example: poor, Gentiles, women)

Women play an important role throughout Luke's Gospel.

This Gospel (like the Gospel of Matthew) probably used the Gospel of Mark and another source for its foundation of stories. Consequently, there are close parallel verses in the Gospels of Mark, Matthew, and Luke.

### ***What can the Gospel of Luke teach me about being a disciple of Jesus Christ?***

Jesus calls *all* people to follow him and to go to the ends of the earth to make disciples of *all* people. (Acts 1:8) Through the Gospel of Luke, we are reminded of the gift of the Holy Spirit, worship and prayer as we live daily as disciples of Jesus Christ.
