Privacy Notice under Gramm Leach Bliley Act

- To Investors in the Mission Investment Fund -

The federal Gramm Leach Bliley Act seeks to protect the privacy of individuals receiving financial services. The Act defines "financial services" broadly and requires a provider of those services to give a statement of its privacy policy to individual clients and customers.

The Mission Investment Fund of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America holds all information obtained from its **individual** investors in confidence, and uses that information only to carry out our responsibilities to investors, such as keeping proper records of investors' holdings, investment transactions, interest payments and related matters.

We will disclose information only when we believe it is necessary for carrying out these responsibilities or as required by law. Otherwise, we will not disclose information without an investor's consent. We will not disclose personal information to non-affiliated third parties.

Upon request we will make available for review by an investor any file we maintain on behalf of that investor.

The above policy applies to all **individual** investors, including former investors.

While the above privacy notification requirements of the Gramm Leach Bliley Act generally apply only to individual investors and not to congregations or ELCA-related institutions, we follow the same confidentiality practices as to our congregational and institutional investors.
