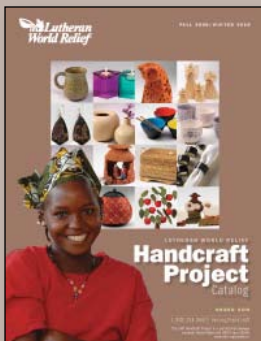


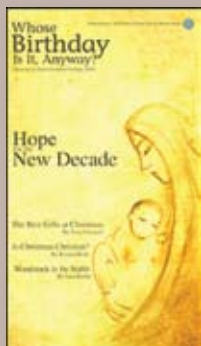
Extra Fun with Fair Trade
