The Northern Evangelical Lutheran Church (NELC) is a multi-ethnic church in India, whose members speak Santali, Boroni, Bengali as well as other languages. The NELC strongly emphasizes spiritual renewal and mission outreach. It also has a number of institutions, including two hospitals, a number of schools, one seminary, two radio ministries and a rural development program.

The NELC's Rural Development Project is located in Dhorompur, an isolated area of the state of Jarkhand. This project reaches out to surrounding villages primarily through field staff who live and work with the people.

Your contributions will help provide activities such as literacy programs, income-generation schemes, health and hygiene, demonstrations of new agricultural methods and cooking techniques that are more favorable to the environment.
