Seminary Scholarships

Project Description

The Augsburg Lutheran Seminary in Mexico is a new expression of the seminary that was opened with the intention of training the leaders of the Lutheran churches in Mexico, Central America, and the northern part of Mexico. The original seminary was also part of an ecumenical effort for theological training. At the present time only Mexican students are being trained at the Augsburg Lutheran Seminary.

Due to the financial limitations of most of the students of Augsburg Lutheran Seminary it is impossible for them to cover the actual cost of their studies; in some cases they enroll in fewer courses because they are not able to pay more. Although some of the students receive a little assistance from their church or congregation, most of the time it does not cover their needs.

Your contributions will help provide scholarships for seminary students who could not otherwise take classes at Augsburg Lutheran Seminary in Mexico.
